his will be the last edition of the Cornerstone that will be mailed to every alumnus on the mailing list. Since 2006, printed copies of the Cornerstone have been mailed twice a year to all of the 10,000 plus living graduates of Fremont High School. Because the Foundation was a new kid on the block, it was the best way to acquaint alums with this new organization, which has since become such an important player in the life of the Fremont Public Schools. The Foundation Board wanted to ensure that all Fremont Public School alumni and supporters were aware that the Foundation provided an avenue through which private support could flow to the Fremont Public Schools. Tax deductible donations have become essential in helping to keep the Fremont Public Schools strong as the Fremont school system has become more and more aligned with, and compared to affluent suburban Omaha Schools.

It has become obvious that the successful organizations of today are making use of digital avenues to reach their constituents. It is particularly important for the Foundation to move in this direction as a means of helping the current classes of graduating seniors to remain connected with their school system. As one of our Board members put it when talking about her children, recent FHS graduates, "if they can't read it on their laptop or cell phone, they probably won't read

it!" Add to this the fact that the per copy cost of printing and mailing have risen to over a dollar for each Cornerstone mailed out, and the time has come to re-evaluate whether the funds being spent to mail out the Cornerstone could be better used to support the primary mission of Foundation, which is to provide support for the Fremont Public Schools. With the ability to digitally make the Cornerstone available to anyone with a computer or smartphone, the obvious answer is "yes".

Fremont. The new wrinkle this year for our readers is the opportunity to make a donation to the Foundation on-line through our new, interactive website. For those of you who find that a convenient way to do business, we encourage you to utilize this new service. Here's a friendly reminder, that the Foundation receives no tax support, and is entirely dependent on donations in order to continue its important work. A donation to the Foundation is like planting a tree that will provide shade for future generations. It's a vote for the future of our children, our school system, our community and our country.

Finally, the death of Marion Iversen, a long time FPS administrator needs to be noted here because of the enormous impact she had on the Fremont Public Schools and its elementary students. As the Director of Elementary Education and subsequently Assistant Superintendent, she was the overseer of all elementary schools and the programs contained therein. While her position was not as public as some, her impact was huge, and thousands of elementary children enjoyed a safe, well-organized K-6 education because of her leadership.

Fremont Public Schools Receives School Climate Transformation Grant

remont Public Schools is among more than 100 school districts nationwide that will benefit from an investment from the U.S. Department of Education to improve school climate and keep students safe.

Fremont Public Schools received a \$750,000 School Climate Transformation grant from the U.S. Department of Education. The grant will provide "\$750,000 per year for the next five years, for a total of \$3.75 million over the life of the grant.

Fremont Public Schools Superintendent Mark Shepard said the district wrote the grant based on a program it started to implement about two years ago. The grant funds will be used to fully implement Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) in kindergarten through 12th grade.

"We're really excited about the opportunity that being awarded this grant is going to provide us with," said Shepard. The development of proficiency in appropriate social skills and behaviors is one of the goals of the Fremont Board of Education. The PBIS program is part of the board's action plan to reach that goal. Shepard said the PBIS program will be implemented in stages, beginning with kindergarten through fourth grade in the first two years of the grant, followed by grades 5 to 8 and finally 9 through 12.

"For our district, where we've already started the process of implementing PBIS, this gives us a huge shot in the arm to really move toward full implementation," Shepard said. "We feel very fortunate we're one of three school districts in the state to receive this grant this year.

"It gives us an opportunity to have the funding available to fully implement a program that we've already started to implement, and really implement it to a level where it could make a difference," he added. "Oftentimes you receive grants and it requires you to do something beyond what you are already doing, or change directions, change focus. I think the great thing about this grant, it ties right in to the direction we're already going."

The School Climate Transformation grants are a part of the "Now is the Time" initiative, which is a comprehensive plan to make schools safer, reduce gun violence by keeping guns out of the hands of dangerous people and increasing mental health services, according to a U.S. Department of Education news release.

FHS Girl's Basketball Team Headed for Arizona

The Fremont High Girl's basketball team is headed for the Nike Tournament of Champions in Phoenix Arizona. The Tigers were invited to participate in the elite tournament based on the strength of players returning from last year's 22-4 campaign as well as promising newcomers.

The Tiger's starting lineup will include the third-ranked prep player in the nation (Nebraska recruit Jessica Shepard), Northwest Missouri State recruit Ashley Nelson and University of Nebraska at Omaha volleyball recruit Gessica Gdowski. Point guard Rylie Cascio Jensen is receiving NCAA Division I interest while fellow junior Meghan Luper is a letter-winner in basketball and golf.

The cost of the trip, which will take place during the Christmas break, will be covered entirely from donations gathered from private citizens and businesses in the Fremont area. This represents a first for a Fremont team. The FPS Foundation served as the repository for the tax deductible donations, which came from over 150 Fremont Public School supporters.

Moran Appointed to Foundation Board

Fremont Public Schools Board of Education member, Dan Moran, has been appointed to serve as the School Board's representative on the FPS Foundation Board. Sandy McDuffee, a twenty year member of the Board of Education, has been the school board representative on the Foundation Board since its founding. She recently retired from the School Board and the foundation board, creating the need for a replacement. Foundation bylaws require that a school board member will always be on the board of the Foundation. While a member of the Foundation Board, McDuffee has served as the Foundation Treasurer.

At the December Foundation Board meeting, the Board accepted her resignation with regret, and applauded her years of service to the Fremont Public Schools. Butch McDuffee was elected to assume the role of treasurer.

Moran, who has served on the school board since 2001, commented on his appointment to the Foundation Board. "I've watched the Foundation from its start up to today, where it has developed into a major contributor in supporting the children in our district get the best education they can. It has been exciting! Now as a board member, I hope I can contribute to continuing to grow the benefits it brings to the school district."

Marion Iversen, Long Time Fremont Administrator Dies at 94

Marion Iversen, who served as a Fremont teacher and administrator from 1946 to 1989, died on Thanksgiving Day at the age of 94. She began her career in Fremont as a teacher at Washington School in 1946, became Principal of Washington School in 1949, became the Director of Elementary Education in 1965, and Assistant Superintendent in 1975. During her tenure directing Fremont's Elementary Schools, over 7,000 elementary children passed through those halls. She was known to teachers and administrators who worked under her as a strong, compassionate leader. Following her retirement in 1989 she remained active in a number of community activities including Altrusa, Delta Kappa Gamma, Memorial Hospital Auxiliary, Dodge County Historical Society, the Board of the Fremont Area Community Foundation, and the Board of the Fremont Salvation Army.
