Fremont Public Schools Foundation's "Chromebooks for Kids" Reaches Goal!

★ The second largest fund raising effort ever taken on by the Fremont Public School Foundation went over the top in less than four months this summer. The Chromebooks for Kids campaign was designed to raise funds for the purchase of 750 Chromebooks for student use and was part of a larger project in which Foundation and District funds were utilized to provide Chromebooks for all students in grades 5 through 12 as part of the FPS District's 1:1 initiative.

The ambitious Foundation project, chaired by Foundation Board President Jennifer Benson, was kicked off with a \$40,000 grant from the Fremont Area Community Foundation in May, plus \$10,257 from the Fremont Area Big Give day of giving. A number of major donations from businesses and individuals got the ball rolling early in the campaign, including \$10,000 gifts from First State Bank, First National Bank, Dale and Fern Olson and an anonymous challenge gift. Additional \$5,000 donations by Pinnacle Back, Sid Dillon Chevrolet and Dick and Paula Hendriksen pushed the campaign more than half way to the goal of \$160,000.

Several teachers and Foundation staff made numerous presentations to potential donors and service clubs. In addition, every FPS Foundation Board member personally called on several Fremont businesses to solicit their support. Finally, hundreds of parents and FPS supporters made contributions to make the completion of the project possible.

The Chromebooks were distributed to students at the start of the second quarter by the FPS Foundation Board and the FPS Information Technology staff.

FHS Superintendent, Mark Shepard praised the effort, noting that the project insures that the over 2,800 children in Fremont's 5th through 12th grades will now have access to another piece of current technology.

FPS Foundation Board President Jennifer Benson said that the project provided a great example of the Fremont Community coming together to support education for children. "To be able to raise over over \$160,000 in such a short period is a real tribute to our community, and its commitment to the importance of our children's education."

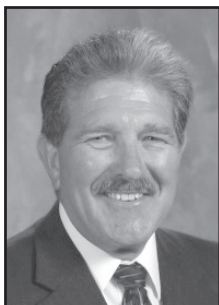

From the Superintendent

Fremont Public Schools and Midland University recently announced a new strategic partnership that will greatly enhance our community students' ability to attend and graduate from college! To this end the two institutions have adopted a "grow your own, keep your own" initiative targeting Fremont High School graduates with their new Tiger to Warrior Scholarship program.

The program is available to all Fremont High School graduates and provides a scholarship, renewable for four years, based on the student's high school grade point average and their ACT score. Additional needs-based-aid may be applied for, as well as athletic and performing arts awards. This program, coupled with Midland's Four Year Guarantee make obtaining a four year degree much more affordable for our Fremont graduates.

"This represents a group of potential students that Midland historically has not had much success in tapping into," commented Merritt Nelson, Vice President for Enrollment Management and Marketing. Fremont High School graduates 320 to 350 students a year and this program provides them an opportunity to continue their education in Fremont at Midland University at a cost below that of attending other private or State colleges or the University of Nebraska. The students have the ability to live at home, further reducing the costs associated with obtaining a four year degree. "This program is made possible by the generous support from our local donors, partners and alumni."

In my mind this is a game changer for our students, their families, Midland University and our community! Fremont has continued to lag behind other similar sized communities in Nebraska when comparisons are drawn based on education attainment levels in the home. The correlation between education attainment and earning potential is very strong and this program has potential to move the needle in a very positive direction for our students, employers and community.

Fremont Public Schools has had a longstanding relationship with Midland University and has cooperated on facility use, dual credit courses and college/career exploration. FPS Foundation Provides a Conduit for Donor Specific Gifts

The Fremont Public School Foundation supports the Fremont Public Schools in a variety of ways. The Foundation takes the lead for fund raising for major projects, i.e. Chromebooks, FHS Track and Field renovation, iPads, LED Projectors in every classroom, Automatic External Defibrillators in all Fremont Schools, including Bergan and Trinity, Nell McPherson Theatre and stage renovation.

In addition, the Foundation continues to support several ongoing projects such as Creative Teaching Grants, Academic Achievement Banquet, FPS Marketing Campaign, Dual Credit Financial Assistance, Making a Difference, and managing over 40 "flow through" accounts for FPS entities.

One area that sometimes gets overlooked is the ability of the Foundation to serve as the financial conduit for donor specific gifts. In the past year, several projects/items totaling over \$164,000 have been funded using this resource.

Items supported in this manner include:

- The FPS Activity Calendar, produced by the Communications and PR department solicits donations through the Foundation to pay for the cost of production.
- As mentioned above, the FHS Track and Field renovation project has had over \$60,000 donated to the Foundation for this cause.
- Last year, an anonymous donor gifted over \$53,000 to purchase state-of-the-art concussion alert football helmets for grades 9-12.
- Another anonymous donation of over \$2,500 paid for the FHS Girls' Tennis Team uniforms.
- Through the Foundation's Making a Difference website, a marimba and stand were purchased for the FHS Marching Band and STEM materials were purchased for Washington Elementary, a total donation of over \$6,000.
- A Big Red Keno Grant of \$7,500 was given to the Foundation to purchase micrometers for the FHS Industrial Technology program.
- The Fremont Area Community Foundation gifted \$26,000 to the Foundation to purchase tubas for the FHS Marching Band.
- First State Bank gave a \$5,000 donation to the FPS Foundation to support the district School Messenger communication service.
- Bank of the West donated \$2,500 toward the John Baylor ACT Test Prep program.

All memorial monies are deposited into the Foundation's Creative Teaching Grant fund. These grants are awarded annually to FPS teachers through an application process. The purpose of these grants is to allow teachers to create, design, or implement programs that promote student achievement, enhance the learning environment, or provide opportunities beyond the traditional classroom setting. Since its inception, the Foundation has granted over \$50,000 to FPS teachers through this program.
