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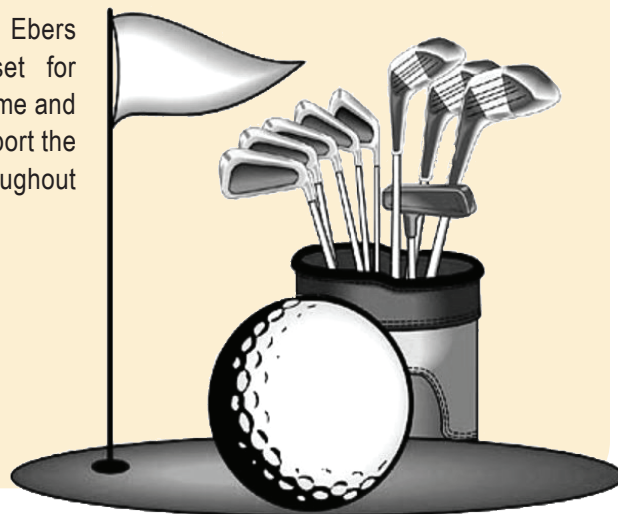

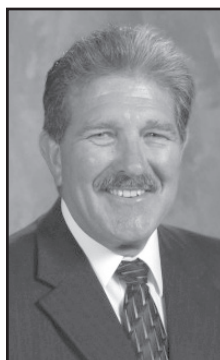
Jim Ebers Golf Classic Coming Soon!!!

FHS Alumni Scholarships Aid Deserving Students

One of the important programs supported by the Fremont Public School Foundation and the Fremont Alumni Association is the Fremont Public School Foundation Student-Aid Endowment Fund. This fund has been providing financial assistance to deserving FHS graduates currently attending a post-secondary institution for over 10 years and has awarded more than \$95,000 during this time. The scholarship is renewable throughout undergraduate years and the amount of the scholarship award is determined upon selection of each student.

This year the program awarded a total of \$3,500 to two deserving Fremont High graduates, Megan Giese, a 2016 FHS graduate and Juanita Mendoza, a 2019 FHS graduate. To show you the impact of these grants, a portion of a thank you received is included below:

"Thank you so much for making this scholarship possible. I am very honored to be the recipient.

This fall, I will be a senior in the Diagnostic Medical Sonography program at Bryan College of Health Sciences. Every year the FAFSA calculates an unrealistic estimated family contribution amount for my siblings and I, so I am very grateful to receive this scholarship. Because of this scholarship, I will be able to focus more on my clinicals and studying for Board exams and decrease the number of hours I work each week.

Thank you again for the wonderful contribution. Receiving this scholarship motivates me to do well in school and complete my degree."

The program funds are managed by the Fremont Area Community Foundation, and gifts to the program can be made directly to the Community Foundation or to the Fremont Public School Foundation which forwards all scholarship donations to the Community Foundation. CF Industries Awards Mini Grants

CF Industries awarded 9 Milliken Park Elementary teachers with mini-grant funds of over \$3,100 this school year through the Fremont Public School Foundation. The mini-grants were to provide funding for classroom projects incorporating Agriculture or the Environment, with the top priority being water quality education.

"Our teachers use the mini-grants to give students unique learning experiences," said Daniel Whitney, Superintendent of CF Industries' Fremont Terminal. "Helping local teachers bring new and exciting opportunities focused on agriculture and the environment to the classroom has been one of our best investments."

The funds provided transportation for field trips for grades K-4 and over 220 students to a variety of venues, including the Henry Doorly Zoo, Lincoln's Children's Zoo, Lauritzen Gardens, WildFire Safari, and Morrill Hall. The staff at Milliken successfully incorporated these

On May 5th of this year, the Fremont Public School Foundation, along with over 60 other non-profit groups from the Fremont area, participated in the Fremont Area Community Foundation’s fourth annual day-of-giving called the “Big Give”. A total over \$300,000 was raised during this event.

With over 90 donors, our Foundation raised almost \$15,000 through this event. These donations will be placed into the “Dual Credit Assistance” fund at the FPS Foundation, which helps students take Dual Credit classes through Metro, Midland, or other post-secondary institutions. With the amount raised, we should be able to assist quite a few students next year!! ★

Fremont Public Schools Foundation Awards Creative Teaching Grants for 2020

The FPS Foundation once again honored creative teaching and innovative strategies of several faculty members in the district by awarding over \$4,800 in funds for Creative Teaching Grants. With over 30 applications, the grants were distributed to 11 teachers representing elementary, middle and high school programs.

The Creative Teaching Grant Program, initiated in 2009-10, annually makes grants to allow teachers to create, design, or implement programs that promote student achievement, enhance the learning environment, or provide opportunities beyond the traditional classroom setting. The grant money may be applied to materials, training, equipment or special programs. With this year’s grants, over \$60,000 has been directed back to classrooms and educators.

Angie Hansen, Spanish/ELL teacher at FHS, requested and received monies to purchase Graphic Novels in Spanish. These books will help strengthen the learning of the Spanish language for students at FHS and assist ELL students with their transition to English.

April Roberson, 1st Grade teacher at Bell Field, was awarded a grant to purchase Language Arts and Math materials for her students to use in their “Hands-On Center”. The Hands-On Center focuses on student-centered learning, engaging in questioning, problem solving, collaboration and hands-on, open-ended activities while addressing real-life issues.

Linden Elementary Kindergarten teachers, Keena Plantegna, Natalie Guenther and Nicole Martens, received funding to cover the costs of field trip to the Rose Theater in Omaha to see “The Little Engine That Could”. The book is included in their Reading Curriculum, and viewing the play serves to enhance the background knowledge for their students, especially their ELL students.

Michelle Whitman, a Johnson Crossing 6th grade English Language Arts teacher, received money to take a field trip to the Lied Center in Omaha. This grant, coupled with a grant from the Nebraska Arts Council, allowed all 6th grade students at Johnson Crossing to attend the Lied Center, with a goal of expanding their cultural awareness as well as gaining background knowledge as it pertains to the Artistic expression of performance and the infusion of scientific principles as they pertain to Newton’s Laws.

Jessica Sorensen, Charlee Wiese. Kara Gilbert and Ariana Struck, Special Education teachers at Pathfinder, Bell Field, FHS and Howard respectively, were awarded funding for Sensory Room and Task Box items to provide their students with personalized sensory input and improve fine motor skills for low cognitive learners, along with providing them with independent level work tasks.

Finally, **Fremont High German teacher, Brenda Schiermeyer**, requested and received funding to purchase headphones and microphones for Fremont High School German students. This equipment will provide students with a project-based, differentiated curriculum.

As always, the FPS Foundation is proud of the quality of our teaching staff and their commitment to professional development, creativity and innovation, and the focus on improving student performance. The Foundation Board thanks everyone who remembers the Foundation with their memorial funds so that we can continue to fund these grant programs. ★
