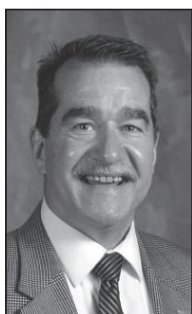
Over the last five years, the FPS Foundation has awarded more \$63,000 in scholarships!

- Enriching the quality of life for Fremont

Superintendent, Dr. Steve Sexton, future Superintendent, Mark Shepard, our first Executive Director, Dr. David Pinkall, David Christensen, Sandy McDuffee, David Simmons, Steve Pribnow, and Jane Dugan along with others understood that today, our students compete with others not just in our state; not just in the mid-west, not just in the United States, but throughout the world.
