Awarding these tuition assistance scholarships to needy students continues to be one of the most impactful FPS Foundation programs!

FPS Foundation Awards 2021/2022 Creative Teaching Grants!



Sixteen Fremont Public School teachers were awarded Creative Teaching Grants from the FPS Foundation in the 2021/2022 school year totaling almost \$7,000.00!

Each year since the 2009/2010 school year, the Fremont Public School

Foundation has awarded Creative Teaching Grants to our teachers allowing them to create, design, or implement programs that promote student achievement, enhance the learning environment, or provide opportunities beyond the traditional classroom setting. The grant money may be applied to materials, training, equipment, or special programs. Over the past 13 years, your Foundation has provided more than \$68,000 to Fremont educators!

This year's Creative Teaching Grant recipients are:

Kelsi Bahe, Kindergarten Teacher at Bell Field Elementary, requested and received funds to improve the access to technology for students in Preschool, Kindergarten, and Special Education through the use of interactive white board applications.

Sadie Brown and Mandy Reilly, 3rd grade Teachers at Linden Elementary, each received funds to purchase STEM Bins to encourage students to create, invent, solve problems using real-world challenges and develop critical thinking skills. The STEM Bins provide an open-ended and developmentally appropriate foundation of engineering for elementary students. These STEM Bins can be used individually, in small groups, or in whole group exploration.

Dana Fontaine, Library Media Specialist at Fremont High School, requested and received the necessary funds to help create a student led news program for school announcements. This news program will be created in correlation with the FHS Journalism Teacher, David Stevens, and will allow students to create short news programs communicating school announcements while learning about video production.

Heather Gallagher, English Language Learning Teacher at Fremont Middle School, received funds to pay for a field trip for her class of Newcomers, to the Nebraska State Capitol to reinforce their learning about the three branches of our government.

Melissa Gates, Literacy Facilitator at Milliken Park Elementary, was awarded a grant to purchase Student Phonics Kits that help provide explicit multi-sensory practice for students who have decoding weaknesses. This allows an alternative hands-on way for students to learn to reach beyond just paper and pencil practice.

Kara Gilbert, Special Education Teacher at Fremont High School, received funds to provide unique and hands on individual learning opportunities to help students in her program reach their learning goals. The Work/Teach Boxes are a common instructional tool that can be used in classrooms to support academic grade level work.

Joe Hamilton, 3rd grade Teacher at Clarmar Elementary, requested and received the necessary funding to purchase enough grade appropriate books to host a book club for students. The goal of the book club is to be an educational and entertaining way to get students actively involved in reading.

Casie Larsen, Kindergarten Teacher at Milliken Park Elementary, received funding to purchase Osmo – Genius Starter Kits, Coding Games, and Cases. Osmo is a learning system that uses iPads, physical objects, and educational tools to keep kids engaged in learning and building their confidence through hands-on interaction and learning.

Julie Mann, Special Education Teacher at Fremont High School, was awarded funds to purchase a Cricut Maker to create an on-campus job site where her students can do such projects as: make crafts to sell, make bulletin boards and class posters/décor for teachers, make flyers and create projects for school activities. This provides an opportunity for her students to be highlighted in their school community while also gaining vocational experience.

Rebecca Nielsen, 1st grade Dual Language Teacher at Washington Elementary, requested and received the necessary funding to purchase children's literature to promote social emotional development skills and various brain tools that students can use during learning times that promote on-task learning behavior that will also encourage a less distracted learning environment.

Hannah Sederburg, 1st grade Teacher at Grant Elementary, received funding to purchase some expanded seating options for her students. These seating options include floor cushions, wobble chairs, balance balls and seat cushions.

Jess Sorensen, Special Education Teacher at the Pathfinder Program, was awarded funds to purchase materials to expand on the Work Box Task options for her students. These tasks include, sorting, putting on/in, building on, letter and number identification, fine motor skills, building words, cause and effect, matching, etc.

Kristy Voss, English / Language Arts Teacher at Fremont High School, requested and received funding to take approximately 100 student to attend a production at the Orpheum Theater in Omaha. This will allow students from all economic backgrounds the opportunity to attend a professional theatrical performance.

Michelle and Guy Whitman, 6th grade Teachers at Johnson Crossing Academic Center, received funding to purchase materials supporting STEAM projects for their classrooms. These projects will deliver high quality integration of Math, Science, Engineering, Technology, and the Arts in fun collaborative learning experiences.

Your Fremont Public Schools Foundation is proud of the quality of FPS teaching staff and their commitment to professional development, creativity, innovation, and the focus on improving student performance. The Foundation Board of Directors thanks everyone who remembers the Foundation with their memorial gifts so that we can continue to fund these grant programs!

A History of Helping Deserving Students

This year marks the 23rd year that the Alumni Student Aid Fund has provided financial assistance to deserving Fremont High School Graduates. Originally established by Fremont High School class of 1948 alumni, and led for many years by David Christensen, the Alumni Student Aid Fund continues to make it possible for qualified Fremont High School graduates to pursue higher education, having awarded approximately \$93,000 since its inception.

This year the Fund awarded scholarships totaling \$3,500 to Mallory Schleicher (a 2022 graduate) and Shane Miller (a 2021 graduate).

The program funds are now managed by the Fremont Area Community Foundation (FACF), and gifts to the program can be made directly to FACF, or to the Fremont Public School Foundation, which forwards all scholarship donations to the FACF. Those wishing to donate to the scholarship program may use the enclosed gift envelope, and designate the portion of the gift they wish to be placed in the scholarship fund.
